We will sponsor training for our workers in Orality and Storying the Gospel. **431**We can arrange training for workers at a local training event. **470**Total number of workers: **50,426**

5. SCRIPTURE TRANSLATION THROUGH A SET OF ORAL BIBLE STORIES

We commit to recruit a team of two "Scripture Servants" who will help an indigenous storyteller communicate 20-40 stories from Scripture to a people group without the Bible. 295 We will try to find a believer or a "Person of Peace" to be the local contact for language groups in our country with no Scripture. 449

6. OUTREACH EVANGELISM

We are interested in partnering with other churches and organizations for evangelistic outreach in our area. **1,083**

7. INTERNET EVANGELISM

We will help recruit internet missionaries to do online follow-up. 512
